

Registering Students

Registering an OYAP apprentice does not necessarily mean the same commitment as registering a normal apprentice. A registered OYAP apprentice would complete her/his cooperative education placement with the employer/sponsor. The student could return for a future cooperative education placement, work part time and/or summers while attending high school and possibly return to complete her/his Apprenticeship after graduation. Any competencies achieved and/or hours accumulated during this time could be credited towards the student's Apprenticeship. **If the employer/sponsor cannot facilitate future placements and/or employment for this student, the student maintains her/his status with MTCU and gains experience which is transferable to another employer/sponsor.**

Registering an OYAP student as an apprentice presents little risk to an employer. In the Compulsory and Restricted trades the student will need to be registered, in order to work outside the placement hours. An OYAP student registered as an apprentice would qualify for the "Loans for Tools" program and he/she would be exempt from the apprenticeship registration fee.
